The Government of Kenya has received financing from World Bank (WB) toward the cost of implementing De-risking, Inclusion and Value Enhancement of Pastoral Economies Project (DRIVE), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services("the Services") include Consultancy Services for **Resource Mobilization Advisor and Technical Assistant** based at the State Department For Livestock Development (SDLD) to offer technical assistance to the project.

Purpose:

The purpose of this technical assistance is to support the SDLD to establish strong link with key government MDA and facilitate investments and market linkage for pastoral production. The technical assistance provider will work closely with the project team and relevant partners to strategize, plan, and provide advisory to DRIVE project and PS Livestock in promoting investments in livestock value chain within the Government's Bottom-up Economic Transformation Agenda.

Scope of Work

In order to successfully implement the project, SDLD plans to hire a qualified consultant with expertise in promoting private sector investment in livestock value chain. The technical assistance provider's responsibilities will include, but are not limited to:

a. Assessment and Strategy Development:

- Conduct a comprehensive assessment of the Drive and SDLD priority projects' that supports pastoral production system.
- Provide advisory to DRIVE and PS Livestock on creating enabling environment for attracting and retaining investments in the livestock value chain.
- Provide linkage with, State Department for Livestock Development, State Department of Trade and State Department of ICT and digital economy to design and roll out Livestock Identification and Traceability System (LITS)
- Provide advisory to DRIVE and PS Livestock on aligning government and donor support with DRIVE project development objective
- Prepare necessary briefs for PS Livestock regarding investment in livestock sector and related field.
- Support SDLD develop a clear and actionable scale up strategy for attracting \$1 billion worth of private sector resource in the livestock sector by 2030
- Working closely with government agencies to promote livestock production and marketing in potential export markets
- Guide SDLD to develop a framework on public private partnership framework and promotion of commercialization of public sector led initiatives such as abattoirs and holding grounds.

b. Partnership Development:

- Identify and engage with relevant stakeholders, including potential donors, investors, and partners.
- Strengthen existing partnerships (especially between SDLD and KDC) and establish new strategic collaborations to maximize investment in the livestock value chain.
- Support PS Livestock in facilitating meetings, workshops, and events to foster collaboration and showcase the project's potential impact.

c. Proposal and Pitch Development:

- Work closely with county governments to identify potential investment opportunities in the livestock sector and help in compiling these opportunities for sharing with potential investors
- Support the development of compelling project proposals and pitches targeted at specific funding sources and investors with a view of enhancing economic contribution from livestock sector
- Provide guidance on crafting persuasive narratives and presenting DRIVE and other priority projects benefits, outcomes, and sustainability.

d. Capacity Building:

- Work with the project team to enhance coordination between the DRIVE implementing partners.
- Facilitate engagement with development partners and donors to enhance investments in livestock sector.
- Identify gaps or challenges that hinder investment in livestock value chain and organize training sessions or workshops for discussing and devising solutions to the challenges.

e. Monitoring and Reporting:

- Regularly monitor and evaluate the progress of resource mobilization efforts and inform the PS livestock.
- Prepare detailed progress reports, including updates on funds secured, partnership developments, and challenges faced.

- Five (5) years' experience working in the international relations sector in the last seven (7) years.
- Five (5) years' experience in promoting private sector resource mobilization preferably in the livestock sector in the last seven (7) years.
- Two (2) assignments on business analysis and business development related to Resource Mobilizations in the last seven (7) years.
- Provide at least two (2) resource mobilization concept for County and National government projects, preferably in the livestock sector that have been funded in the last seven (7) years.
- Provide evidence of three (3) resource mobilization transactions that have initiated, sourced, structured, and managing in the last seven (7) years.
- Five years (5) experience working with three (3) projects in County Government, National Government and World the Bank projects
