THE AGRICULTURAL MECHANIZATION ACT, 2021

(No. 1 of 2021)

The Agricultural Mechanization (Agricultural Mechanization, General) Regulations, 2021.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by Section 46 of the Agricultural Mechanization Act, 2021, the Cabinet Secretary for Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Cooperatives in consultation with the Board and the County governments, makes the following Regulations—

PART I—PRELIMINARY	
Citation	<p>1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Mechanization (Agricultural Mechanization, General) Regulations, 2021.</p>
Interpretation	<p>2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires— “Act” means the Agricultural Mechanization Act, 2021; “Agricultural Mechanization Inspector” means a person appointed under section 28 of the Act; “Export” means the business of exporting agricultural machinery, equipment, implements and agro-processing plants from Kenya; “Import” means the business of importing agricultural machinery, equipment, implements and agro-processing plants into Kenya; “Licensing Authority” means the Board or the County Government as the case may be;</p>
Objective and Purpose	<p>3. (1) The purpose of these regulations is to develop, promote and regulate the growth of the agricultural mechanization in Kenya. (2) Without prejudice to the generality of sub-regulation (1), these regulations shall provide for: - a) Effective regulation of Agricultural Mechanization in Kenya b) Quality assurance and standards in Agricultural Mechanization sub-sector. c) Promotion of research, technology development and adoption.</p>
Application	<p>4. These Regulations shall be applicable to all agricultural machinery, equipment, implements, agro-structures and agricultural processing plants as specified in</p>

PART II: REGISTRATION AND LICENSING	
Registration of commercial manufacturers, exporters, importers and consultant	<p>5. (1) No person shall manufacture, export or import agricultural machinery, equipment or implement for commercial purposes without a valid registration certificate issued by the Board.</p> <p>(2) No person shall act as consultant for agro-structures and agro-processing plants for commercial purposes without a valid registration certificate issued by the Board</p> <p>(3) An application for registration under regulation (1) and (2) shall be made to the Board in Form A1 as prescribed in the First Schedule and shall fulfill the following requirements—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) be a company, individual or such other legal entity registered in Kenya; (b) have qualified personnel in agricultural mechanization or ability to engage the same. (c) Except for exporters, demonstrate ability to offer aftersales services. <p>(4) The applicant shall pay a non-refundable application fee to the Board, as set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations.</p>
Issuance of a registration certificate for commercial manufacturers, exporters, importers and consultant	<p>6. (1) The Board shall, within 14 days of receipt of the application, issue a registration certificate to the successful applicant.</p> <p>(2) The certificate shall be as prescribed in Form A2 in the First Schedule</p> <p>(3) Where a registration certificate is not granted, the Board shall within 14 days inform the applicant in writing stating the reasons for rejection</p> <p>(4) Upon addressing the issues raised in (3) as grounds for rejection of an application the applicant may within 30 days resubmit the application for reconsideration.</p> <p>(5) The registration certificate issued above shall be issued once.</p>
Registration of commercial dealers or service providers	<p>7. (1) No person shall operate as a commercial dealer or service provider without being registered by the County Government.</p> <p>(2) An application for registration as a commercial dealer or service provider shall be made to the County executive committee member in Form B1 under the First Schedule and shall fulfill the following requirements—</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) be a company, individual or such other legal entity registered in Kenya; (b) have qualified personnel in agricultural mechanization or ability to engage the same.

	<p>(c) Except for service providers, shall demonstrate ability to offer aftersales services.</p> <p>(3) Upon receipt of an application, the County Executive Committee Member shall provide feedback to the applicant within 7 days.</p> <p>(4) The applicant shall pay a non-refundable application fee to the respective County government, as set out in the Second Schedule of these Regulations.</p>
Issuance of a registration certificate for commercial dealers or service provider	<p>8. (1) The County Executive Committee Member shall, within 14 days from the date of application, issue a registration certificate to the successful applicant</p> <p>(2) The certificate in (1) shall be as prescribed in Form B2 in the First schedule.</p> <p>(3) Where a registration certificate is not granted, the County Executive Committee Member shall inform the applicant in writing stating the reasons of the rejection within 14 days from the date of the application.</p> <p>(4) Upon addressing the issues raised as grounds for rejection of an application, the applicant may resubmit the application for reconsideration.</p> <p>(5) The registration certificate shall be issued once.</p> <p>(6) The certificate issued under this regulation is not transferable.</p>
Licensing of manufacturer, exporter importer and consultant	<p>9. (1) No person shall operate as an agricultural machinery manufacturer, exporter, importer or consultant without a license from the Board.</p> <p>(2) An application for the license shall be made to the Board as prescribed in Form C1 in the First Schedule</p> <p>(3) the license shall be prescribed in Form C2 in the First Schedule</p>
Licensing for commercial dealers or service provider	<p>10. (1) No person shall operate as an agricultural machinery commercial dealer or service provider without a license from the County Government.</p> <p>(2) An application for the license shall be made to the County Government as prescribed in Form D1 in the First Schedule.</p> <p>(3) The license shall be as prescribed in Form D2 of the First Schedule.</p>
Application for license	<p>11. (1) An application for the license shall be accompanied by the following documents;</p> <p>(a) Personal identification documents</p> <p>(b) Certificate of registration issued under regulation (7) or (8) as the case may be</p>
Renewal of a license	<p>12. (1) A person intending to have manufacturer, importer or exporter license renewed shall make an application to the Board in Form C1 in the First Schedule</p>

	<p>(2) A person intending to have the commercial dealer, consultant or service provider license renewed shall make an application to the respective County Government in Form D1 in the First Schedule</p> <p>(3) The Board or the County Executive Committee Member shall renew the license for the applicant who has fulfilled the requirements for the application, within three (3) days from the date of application.</p>
Suspension and Revocation of a license	<p>13. (1) The Board or County Executive Committee Member as the case may be may suspend or revoke a license where the license holder has violated the conditions of the license.</p> <p>(2) Before the license is suspended, the Board or the County Executive Committee Member shall give the license holder a 7-day notice to address the non-compliance</p> <p>(3) Where the license holder fails to address the non-compliance within 7 days, the Board or County Executive Committee Member shall suspend the license for 30 days giving the reasons for suspension and the remedial measures required for lifting of the suspension.</p> <p>(4) During the suspension period, the license holder shall not carry out any activities but shall address the issues of compliance.</p> <p>(5) After 30 days, the Board or the County Executive Committee Member shall assess whether the non-compliance issues have been fully addressed in accordance with the suspension order.</p> <p>(6) If the board or County Executive Committee Member is satisfied that the license holder has fully addressed the non-compliance, the suspension shall be lifted.</p> <p>(7) If the Board or the County Executive Committee Member is not satisfied, that the license holder has addressed the non-compliance, the license shall be revoked.</p>
Register	<p>14. (1) The Board and the County Government shall maintain a register of all the registration certificates and licenses issued under these regulations.</p> <p>(2) the register shall be in both electronic and manual form</p> <p>(3) The register shall contain the following information;</p> <p>(a) Name of the certificate or license holder</p> <p>(b) The category of the business</p> <p>(c) Number and the type of machineries and equipment, location, condition</p> <p>(d) Source or country of manufacture</p> <p>(e) Testing Centre for machinery or equipment</p>

	(f) Any other information the Board and the County Government may consider necessary
PART III: AGRICULTURAL MECHANIZATION QUALITY ASSURANCE AND CERTIFICATION	
Categories of agricultural machinery, and structures	<p>15. (1) The agricultural machinery and structures listed under First Schedule are for the purposes of these regulations.</p> <p>(2) The Cabinet Secretary may, by notice in the Gazette, amend the First Schedule.</p>
Application for testing and certification of agricultural machinery and equipment	<p>16. (1) All agricultural machinery and equipment imported into Kenya shall not be used unless they have been tested and certified by the testing center</p> <p>(2) No person shall sell a locally manufactured or assembled agricultural machinery and equipment unless they have been tested and certified by the testing center.</p> <p>(3) Any person who contravenes regulation 1 and 2 above commits an offence</p> <p>(4) Any person who intends to have their machinery tested and certified shall apply to the Testing Centre using Form (E1) provided in the First Schedule and shall pay the fee prescribed in Second Schedule</p> <p>(5) The Testing and certification of agricultural machinery and equipment listed in the First Schedule shall be done in accordance with procedures for suitability test prescribed by the Board</p> <p>(6) Where the machinery has met all the requirements, the Testing Centre shall issue a certificate of suitability as prescribed in form E2 in the First Schedule</p> <p>(7) Where the machinery has not met the requirements, notification in writing of non-suitability will be issued.</p>
Approval of agro-structures and agro-processing plants designs	<p>17. (1) No person shall establish an agro-structure or agro-processing plant for commercial purposes whose designs have not been approved by the County Government.</p> <p>(2) Any person who intends to have their designs for agro-structures and agro-processing plants approved shall apply to the County government using Form (F1) provided in the First Schedule and shall pay the fees prescribed in the Second Schedule</p> <p>(3) The County Government shall where the application has met the requirements, approve the designs within 14 days</p> <p>(4) Where an application has not been approved, the County Government shall inform the application within 14 days.</p>

Certification of plant operators	<p>18. (1) No person shall operate an agricultural machinery or equipment listed in the Second Schedule for commercial purposes without being certified by the Testing Centre</p> <p>(2) Any person who intends to operate an agricultural machinery and equipment prescribed in the Second Schedule shall apply to the Testing Centre for certification using Form G1 provided in the Second Schedule and shall pay the fee prescribed in Second Schedule</p> <p>(3) Where the applicant has met the requirement, the respective Testing Centre shall issue a certificate as prescribed in form G2 in the Second Schedule within a period of 14 days.</p> <p>(4) Where the applicant has not met the requirement, the Testing Centre shall notify the applicant in writing within 14 days.</p>
Appointment of inspectors	<p>19. (1) The Board and the County Government shall appoint inspectors in accordance with section 28 (1) and (2) of the Act.</p> <p>(2) An inspector appointed under this section shall have the following minimum qualifications;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Diploma in the field of Agricultural Engineering or related fields (b) Be registered with engineering related professional body (c) Have served in the field of agricultural engineering or related fields for a period of 5 years (d) Must have undergone a training on inspection as prescribed by the Board <p>(3) The names of the inspectors appointed under this section shall be published by the Board in the Gazette and issued with a certificate and an identification tag.</p> <p>(4) A person who carries out the functions of an inspector without having been duly appointed under the Act commits an offence.</p>
PART IV- AGRICULTURAL MECHANIZATION RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT	
Approval of new agricultural mechanization technologies	<p>20. (1) No person shall commercialize new agricultural mechanization technologies unless the technology has been approved by the Board</p> <p>(2) A person intending to commercialize new agricultural mechanization technology shall apply for approval of the technology to the Board in Form H1 as outlined in the First Schedule and accompanied by;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) an application fee set out in the Second Schedule (b) technology description report <p>(3) Upon the receipt of the application, the Board shall;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Upon testing the technology, the Board will issue a certificate of approval to a successful applicant within 90 days as set out in Form H2 of First Schedule (b) reject the application and indicate the grounds for rejection.

	(4) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this regulation commits an offence.

(1) Each commercial dealer, exporter, importer and local manufacturer licensed and registered by the Board shall, within 30 days after the end of each financial year prepare and submit annual returns to the Board on matters relating to agricultural mechanization, in accordance to Form J1 in the First Schedule,</p> <p>(2) Each County Government shall, within 30 days after the end of each financial year prepare and share annual returns with the Board on matters relating to agricultural mechanization in accordance to form J2 in the First Schedule</p> <p>(3) The Board shall, within 60 days after the end of each financial year prepare and submit to the Cabinet Secretary annual agricultural mechanization report and share with County Governments and relevant stakeholders, in accordance to Form J3 in the First Schedule</p>
Provision of after sale service, public education and safe use	<p>22. (1) No person shall sell agricultural machinery, technologies, structures, agricultural processing plants, implements and equipment without providing proof of availability of after sale service;</p> <p>(2) The after sales service referred to in (1) shall entail;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) a printed user manual written in English and Kiswahili languages that provides instructions on efficient and safe use of each sold item (b) Proof of availability of spare part dealers in the Country (c) Availability of trained and qualified service personnel <p>(3) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this regulation commits an offence.</p>
Appeals on decisions of the Board and County Governments	<p>23. (1) Any person aggrieved by the refusal of the Board, or of any person authorized by the Board in that behalf, to issue any license or registration certificate, or by any decision of the Board may within thirty days after being notified of such refusal, cancellation, suspension or decision, appeal to the Cabinet Secretary.</p> <p>(2) Any person aggrieved by the refusal of the County Government, or of any person authorized by the County Government in that behalf, to issue any license or registration certificate, or by any decision of the County Government may within thirty days after being notified of such refusal,</p>

	cancellation, suspension or decision, appeal to the County Executive Committee Member.
