

Nambale Livestock Market in Busia County is undergoing renovation by the Kenya Livestock Commercialization Project (KeLCoP), aiming to modernize facilities and enhance economic activities.

Upgrades include a loading ramp, sheds, water points, eatery stalls, livestock holding pens, a modern office block for the Livestock Market Committee, and a state-of-the-art poultry shed. Sanitation improvements involve renovating the ablution block, installing water tanks, and solarizing water systems.

The project has already provided local employment opportunities and boosted sales for nearby food vendors.

Upon completion, the market plans to operate twice weekly, potentially doubling livestock trade and increasing revenue for traders and the county.
