The specialist should have the following minimum qualifications and experience;

- i. A minimum of a Master Degree in Sociology, Anthropology, Social sciences, law, psychology, human rights, Gender and Development studies or other relevant fields from a reputed public university.
ii. A minimum of 6 years of general experience in social risk management and tracing of Gender Based Violence (GBV) with a focus on SEA and SH.
iii. A specific experience of four (4) years in actual gender mainstreaming for development, and GBV/SEAH prevention in development projects in different roles and assignments undertaken at different levels with sector specialists working with Multilateral Organizations, International NGOs, implementing compliance procedures like the ESF and Environmental and Social standards. Evidence of at least 3 comparable assignments.
